ADA comes with a few requirements that are important to know when obtaining compliant signage.

## ADA FEATURES

- Non-glare surfaces (this helps the vision impaired or elderly when trying to read a sign).
- Tactile lettering and icons (the raised surfaces help those with low vision or blindness who cannot read Braille).
- Braille dots (these allow for vision impaired or blind people to read the signs).
- Specific thickness measurements (you don't have to worry about this, because Starfish is very experienced in ADA signage and takes care to make sure your signs are compliant).
